Minutes of the Meeting

The Seventh Academic Council Meeting of Madurai Institute of Social Sciences was chaired by Dr. D. Janet Vasantha Kumari, Principal, MISS.

The meeting was started with Tamizh Thai Vazhthu followed by College Anthem

Welcome Address

Dr. Capt DVP Raja, Founder & Chairman of MISS welcomed the members of the Academic Council and gave his introductory speech.

Dr. Capt DVP Raja, extended warm welcome to Dr. M. Lakshmanan, Former Vice Chancellor of Madurai Kamaraj University, Prof. M. Salihu, Former Vice Chancellor, MKU, Dr. S.Vincent, Dr. C. Chandran, Dr. P.N.Narayana Raja and Prof. S. Koodalingam, Former Principals of MISS, Faculty Members and Student representatives.

He addressed that the Institute was founded on 1969 on the centenary birthday of Mahatma Gandhi. 1st October, the birthday of Dr Annie Besant who also led nation to independence before Mahatma Gandhi was remembered. He was happy to say that after gaining the status of Autonomy, it was the seventh Academic Council meeting. He compared those days with today. He quoted how reputed the college was by quoting an incident where 17 students out of 20 students in HR – Social Work were placed in Madura Coats by Dr. Martin Henry.

Later on, he felt the need of time to start various other fields and courses to instill Value Education and Skill Development for younger generation. Such felt need became reason to start Community College. He recorded his desire to establish Value based Education even in the second campus near Alagar Koil, where younger generation will be nurtured, trained to be responsible persons. He stated the nineteen centers that were started as centre for Excellence, including centre for Buddha, and Swami Vivekananda; where each department is given responsibility for its functioning. He recalled how the Post Graduate in

Human Resource Management was started in 1990 and how it paved way for establishing Foundation for HRD. He assured in his speech that Madurai Institute of Social Sciences will serve for the future development of the country.





Dr. S Murugesan pointed out that there is a course titled "Dynamics of Human Behaviour" which cover the Psychology aspects as suggested by Dr. Nehru

Dr. P Rajkumar suggested to add some relevant paper which is in interdisciplinary nature in the syllabus.

3
Minutes of 9th Academic Council Meeting held on 08/12/2018

It was pointed out by the faculty members of Social Work that already such kind of courses are offering to the students, namely, Introduction on Basic Accounting, Introduction to Basic Computer etc

The academic council members appreciated that the college is providing interdisciplinary kind courses to the students and suggested to give intensive focus on use of computer and technology in learning.

Dr. S Nehru asked for a clarification on the concept of "improvement of Internal mark" which is mentioned in the regulation (Point-17.1). He asked for the clarification of how it was implemented in the institute.

The BoS chairperson of Social Work, Dr. S Murugesan and Mr. M Nisant, the Controller of Examination (CoE) has clarified that the opportunity is giving to improve the score of the students who have below 50% attendance.

Dr. P N Narayana Raja asked whether the institute is providing the redo option after the completion of the course or not? Dr. M Kannan also mentioned that no need to redo after the course is over. Mr. M Nisant, the CoE clarified that when a student's attendance is low, then only the student will go for redo. In order to provide support those students who get low score in the exams, the college is providing remedial courses and helping the students to get good score in the coming exams.



From the Discussions

Dr. Suriyarajan quoted that need not to compromise on the quality of the students and be strict with the award of internal mark of the students.

Dr.P N Narayana Raja was also mentioned that better to create a system for getting better score for the students, in terms of provide more retests. The students can undertake additional work for improving the score before the publication of the internal mark. He also suggested that the internal assessment must be a continuous affair that will help the student to cautious of their score at every time.

Dr. M Salihu, [Former V C] also suggested that the internal assessment must be a strict one and the best interest of the students must also take into consideration.

Mr. M Nisant, the CoE mentioned that there are advanced learners and slow learners, the institute is providing better opportunities for these two categories for their better and improved learning. He also suggested that supplementary exam can be provided to the students not the improvement. He also provided that the Internal Assessment in MISS is continuous assessment in nature, which comprises of 3 internal assessment test and best of 2 is taking for the final awarding of the internal mark.



The Controller of Examination clarifies

Dr. M Kannan was also appreciated that the continuous assessment nature of the internal system is good and also suggested to the teachers that all the assignment and seminar topic need to be given well in advance and the assessment should carry out periodically.

Dr. S Nehru told that as per CBSS there are only 2 tests, the college can conduct 3 or more test but the mark of only 2 tests will be taken into consideration. He also mentioned that if there is a valid reason for being absent by a student, the individual teachers can consider for conducting separate retest for those students.



From the Discussions

Dr. Suriyarajan told that once the internal mark is finalized there cannot be any retest. He also mentioned that the past statistics shows that only very few students are coming under such category, so no need to disturb the smooth running system of the college.
